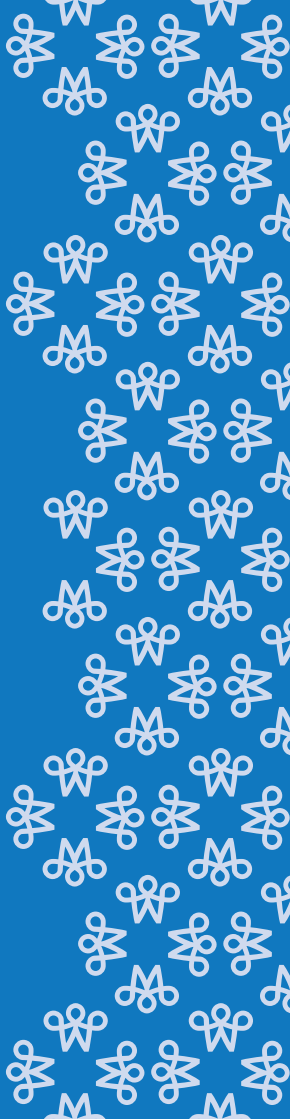

Maimonides Interfaith Foundation is a pioneer in its field.

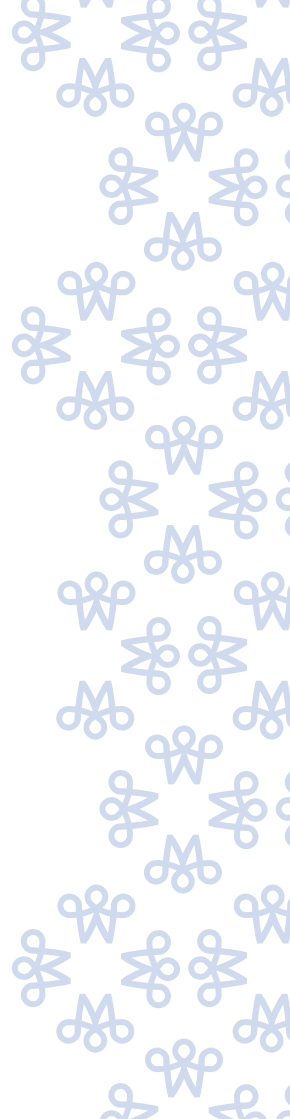
It has been at the forefront of creating a nexus of interreligious dialogue and interaction through a track record of successful arts, cultural, sporting and academic programmes.

Maimonides Interfaith Explorers

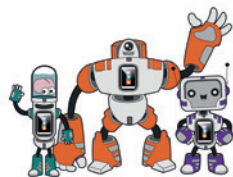
Interfaith Explorers is a free online primary educational learning resource supported by UNESCO. It is designed to develop the core personal and social competencies of children between 10 and 11.
